REDEEMER OSHC VACATION CARE INFORMATION

PROGRAM:

Our program consists of themed days which all involve indoor and outdoor play experiences. All days provide children with options for craft creations, language activities, physical challenges, social games, and plenty of child-led, spontaneous play. Fostering children's social and emotional development is as important to us as supporting their cognitive and physical development, so we love to encourage their creative and imaginative learning with free play opportunities.

BOOKINGS:

All bookings must be made by parents/guardians via the Xplor app. You will not receive any confirmations for standard Vacation Care days but will be able to see your bookings in the app's calendar tab instantly, as noted by a small orange dot on relevant days. Places in additional activities, such as incursions and excursions, will be confirmed via email once forms are received by the service.

INCURSIONS & EXCURSIONS:

A completed authorisation form must be returned to the service with parent/guardian signature prior to all incursions and excursions. Unfortunately, phone, email or verbal permission are not suitable and will not be accepted in replacement of a signed authorisation form.

FOOD & DRINK:

Our program allows for three food breaks (fruit snack at 9.30am, lunch at 12.00pm, optional afternoon tea at 3.00pm). Our service now provides fruit and vegetable platters for both morning and afternoon tea, as well as an afternoon snack, but <u>lunch</u> still needs to be provided by families. Please note we are unable to reheat or refrigerate food. A water bottle is also essential for all days.

ESSENTIALS:

Enclosed shoes, a wide-brimmed hat <u>(no caps</u>), and clothing that covers shoulders and upper arms are a must. Children without may be unable to participate in certain activities at the discretion of educators. If attending BCLS, please also bring a basic pencil case and stationery items.

PERSONAL ITEMS:

Please label all items, including clothing. **Personal phones and/or smart watches are not permitted and will be removed from children.** We strongly discourage children from bringing toys or games from home, and accept no responsibility for any damage, loss, or inappropriate use.

SESSIONS & FEES:

We offer four sessions for Vacation Care: 11hr with or without BCLS from 7.00am to 6.00pm, or 9hr with or without BCLS from 8.30am to 5.30pm. Bookings **made after 15 November for 2024 or after 13 December for 2025** will incur additional admin fees of \$5.00 per day. Sessions with BCLS incur an incursion fee of \$5.00. Your child may only attend within booked session hours. Children booked for the 9hr session who attend outside of session time will be moved to the 11hr session with a \$10.00 admin fee charged.

Children collected after 6.00pm will be charged \$20.00 at 6.00pm and \$5.00 per additional 5 minutes thereafter. Failure to sign children in or out correctly is a breach of CCS obligations and will also incur additional admin fees of \$5.00 per child.

Hats may be provided to children that do not have an appropriate hat (ie: no hat or cap only) at an additional fee of \$15.00 per hat.

7 days' notice is required for cancellations, or full fees will be charged. Absences before your child's first attendance or after your child's last attendance may result in CCS being revoked for these bookings, in which case full fees must be settled by the family. If absent for your final day of VAC, please aim to reattend within 12 weeks of your child's last physical attendance to avoid incurring a later debt.






